Training: Onet Cleaning & Services inaugurates its new training centre dedicated to healthcare professions

On 22nd November, Denis Gasquet, Chairman of the Onet Group's Executive Board, inaugurated a new Onet Cleaning and Services training centre in Valenciennes dedicated to developing the cleaning skills of the Group's employees in the field of healthcare.

This new training centre, located close to the Valenciennes Hospital, the 3rd biggest establishment and Onet Cleaning and Services' main customer in the region, is the culmination of a joint reflection between professionals from the healthcare, pharmaceutical and bio-contamination sectors.

"This geographical proximity will make it possible to better meet our clients' needs since we will be able to train all the Onet employees in the Hauts-de-France region to meet the specific requirements of the healthcare field," explains Christian Tribouillard, Chief Operating Officer of Onet North Hauts-de-France.

In concrete terms, the Onet Group has recruited an executive hygienist trainer, who will run the centre and determine the training programs according to the needs of the different sectors managed. She will be partnered in this project by a pharmacist. The training programs will combine theoretical and practical lessons, with real-life situations. On order to maximise benefit, the premises have been organised according to the classification of zones of infectious risk, with the complete reconstitution of a hospital room and an operating theatre.
