Onet winner of the CEO / HRD Partnership Award 2017

On March 23rd this year, Denis Gasquet and Antoine Recher, respectively Chairman of the Management Board and Human Resources Director of Onet, the services and engineering group, received the 'CEO / HRD Partnership of the year Award 2017', highlighting the human resources policy developed by the two leaders. The company also received the "Public's Favourite" award.

The prize was awarded on the occasion of the 14th ceremony of the 'CEO / HRD Partnership of the year Award 2017', organized by the RH&M GROUP, and held on March 23rd, 2017 at the Palais Brongniart in Paris.

This trophy honours the quality of the relationship between the General Management and the Human Resources Department, as well as their joint commitment towards an innovative social policy. Onet was also awarded the "Public's Favourite" prize among the four winners (Bénéteau, Saint-Gobain and Pierre Fabre).

With 66,000 employees and 136 nationalities represented, Onet's services and engineering group has developed a human resources policy centred on partnering and training their employees whilst ensuring their health and safety.

"Occupational health is one of the priorities in our strategic plan," explained Denis Gasquet at the awards ceremony. In order to achieve this goal, he created the position of HRD for the Group, which previously hadn't existed in this family company, and entrusted it to Antoine Recher.

Antoine Recher paid tribute to the *"deeply human culture of the company, which has always put training and internal promotion at the heart of its values"*, pointing out that 85% of Onet's branch managers were recruited from the Group.

When asked about the challenge of innovation, Denis Gasquet explained that *"the real transformation in the sector will come from the management of data that allows us to envisage the trade from the position of the user"*. At Onet, subsidiaries whose activities are new and innovative are integrated into an *"incubator"* managed by the innovation department whose objective it is to facilitate and support the technological and commercial development of these entities (such as, for example, Sinteo, which was acquired in 2014).
